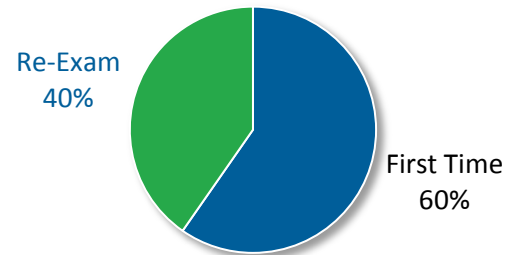

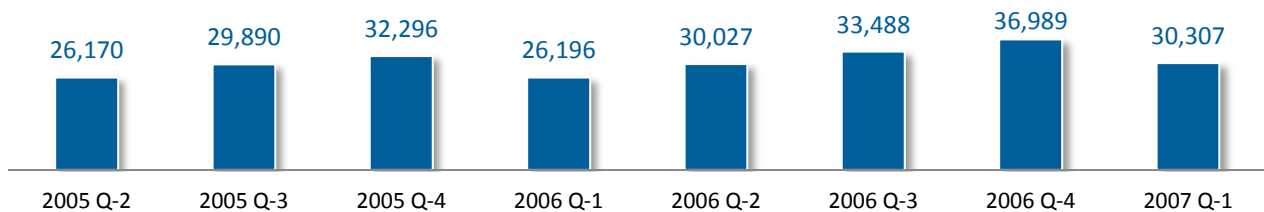

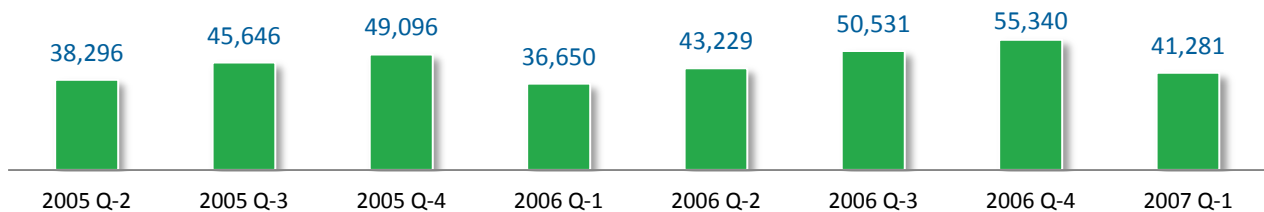
### Exam Type by Percent



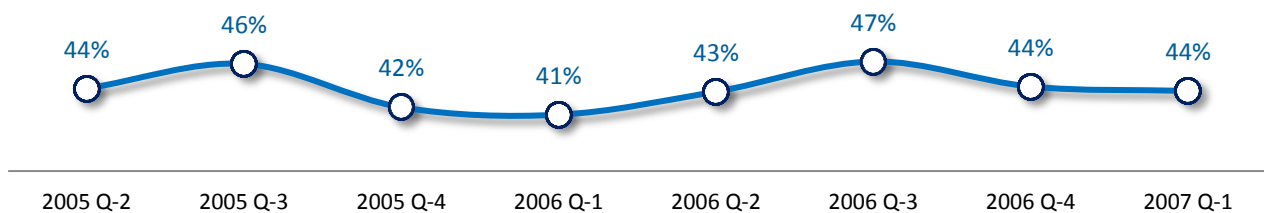

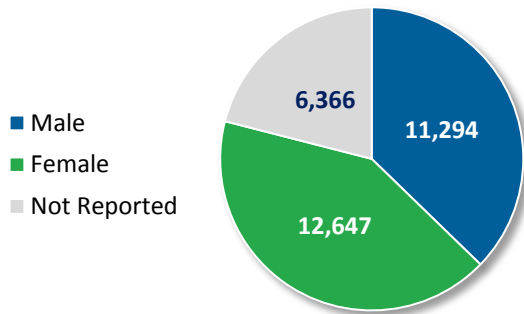

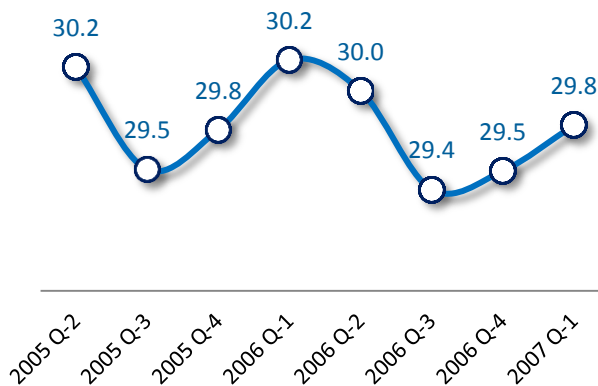

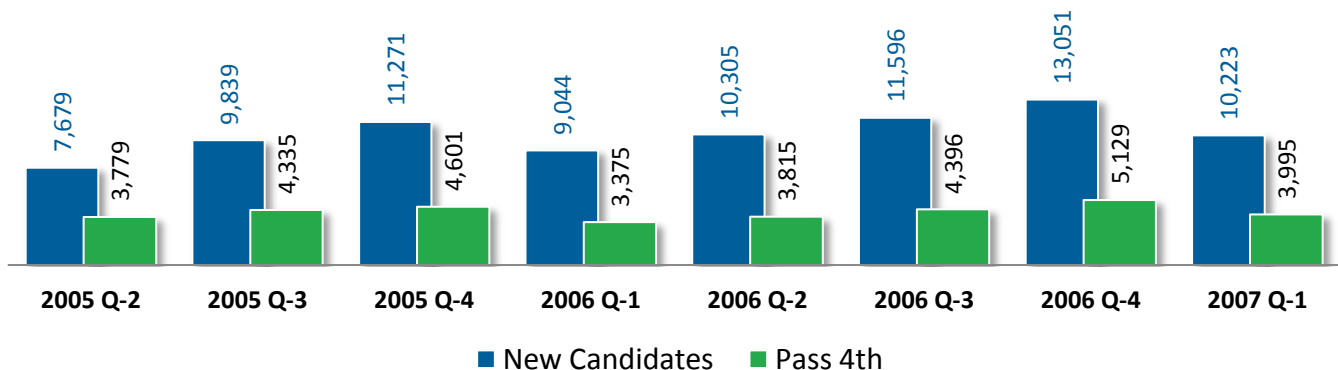
