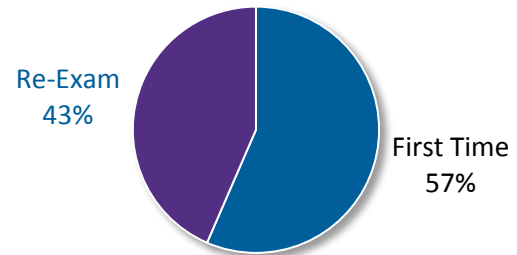

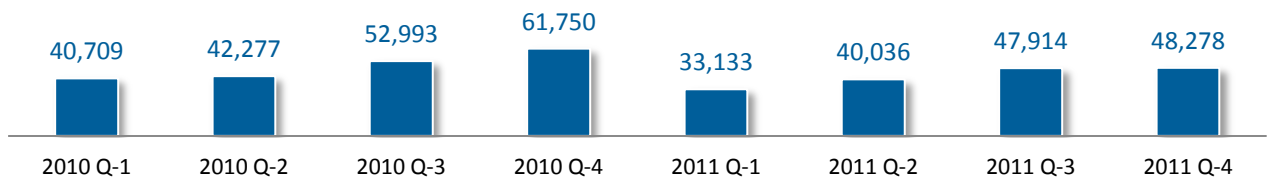

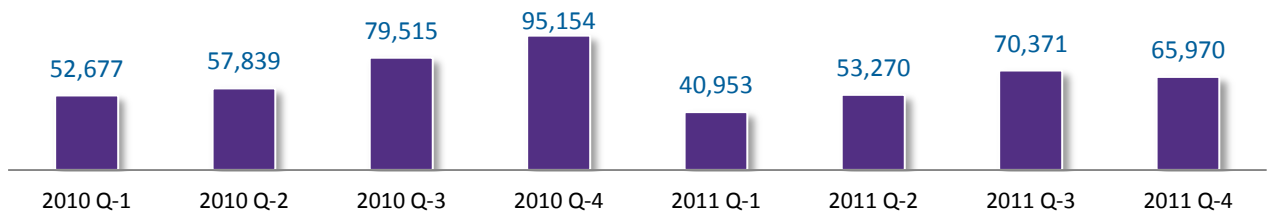
Exam Type by Percent



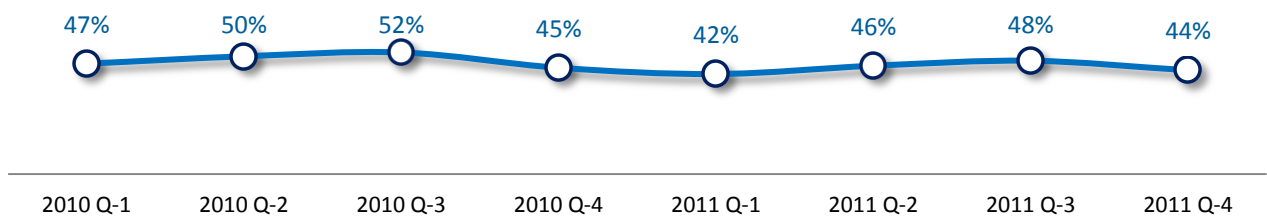

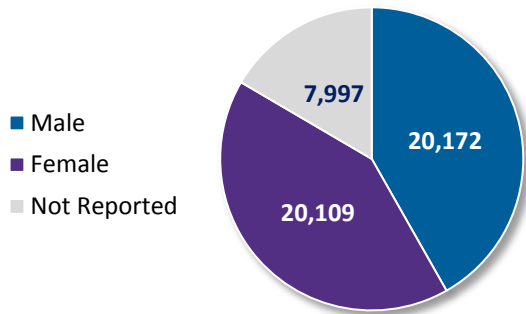

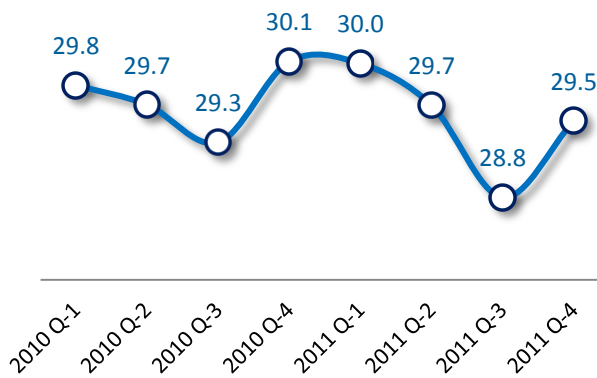

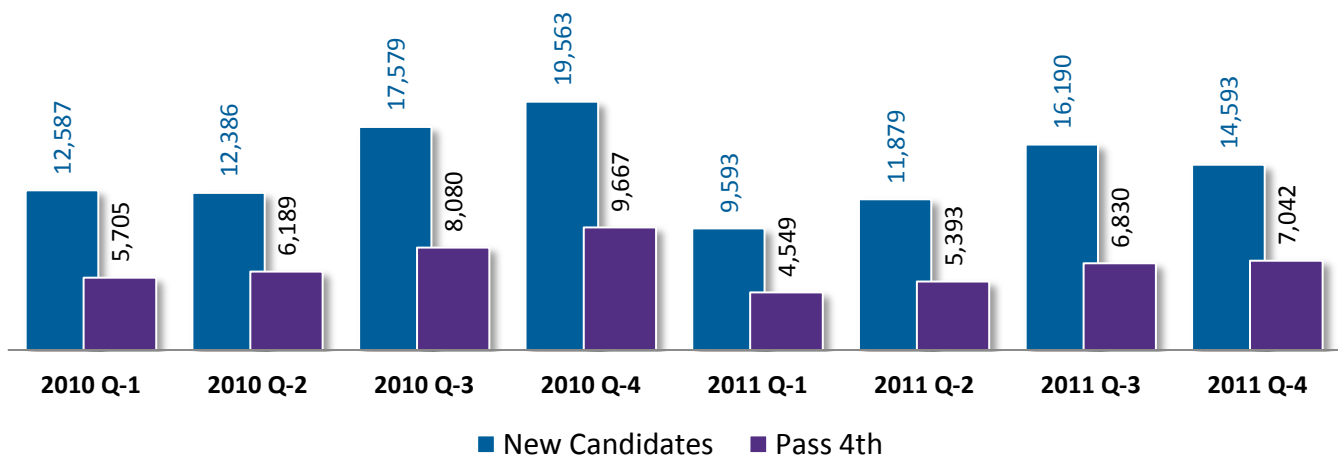
